

After several hair-pulling hours of frustration I managed to identify an issue I was having with bitbucket and *all* of my repositories.

When attempting to *pull*, *push*, *clone*, or perform any action in a bitbucket git repository I was met with the following:

```
conq: repository access denied. deployment key is not associated with  
the requested repository
```

This apparently was caused by a failed ssh identity in MAC OSX after a recent update to OpenSSH. I have no logical explanation, but the solution was quite simple:

```
ssh-add ~/.ssh/PRIVATE_KEY_NAME
```

For most people, that means: `ssh-add ~/.ssh/id_rsa`
